1 LAND DEGRADATION

Massive use of chemical such as pesticides & fertilizers reduces the fertility of soil. Farmers can be motivated for judicious application of fertilizers.



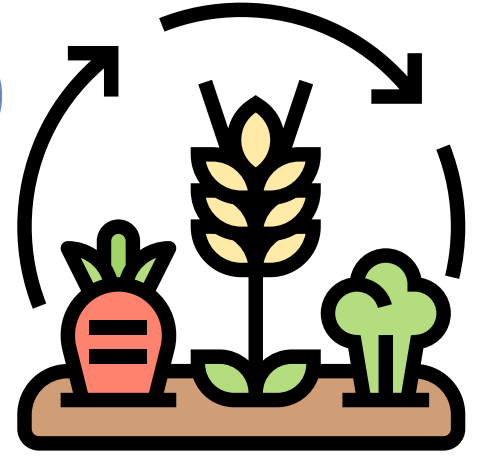
2 PER CAPITA LAND HOLDING

Most holdings are small and uneconomic, so advantages of large scale farming are not possible now, as a result farmers don't get maximum produce.



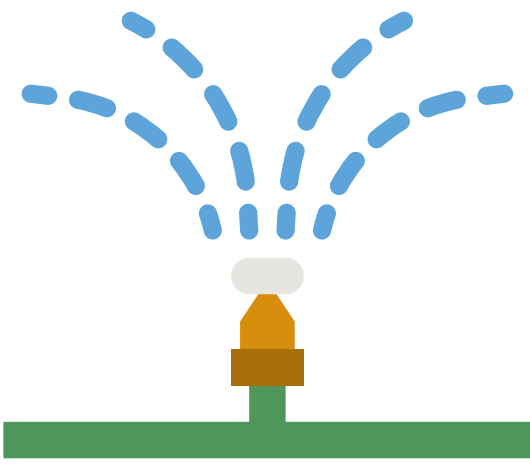
3 NEGLECT CROP ROTATION

Farmers usually cultivate same type of crop year after year & the land loses its fertility. farmers are reluctant to adopt new practice instead of continuing the practices followed by their predecessors.



4 INADEQUATE IRRIGATION FACILITY

A huge amount of remains uncultivated for lacks of irrigation facility; there is a need for more & more irrigation projects to bring the whole cultivable areas under irrigated conditions.



5 LABOUR PROBLEMS

Urbanization, migration to cities & rising wages of MGNREGS create scarcity of agricultural labours.



6 POOR INFRASTRUCTURE

Connecting the producing centers with urban areas is of immense need. Due to lack of better communication facilities, Farmers depend on middlemen for the disposal of his produce at cheap prices.
