

Land Reforms



Abolition of intermediaries

- · Abolition of Zamindari System.
- Ownership rights have been conferred upon those who actually cultivate soil



Regulation of Rent



- Fixation of Rents.
- Generally, these are not to exceed 1/3rd of the value of crop.

Consolidation of Holdings

• It is a practice to allot land to the farmer at one place as a replacement for hi scattered holding here and there leading to saving the cost of cultivation

Ceiling on Land Holding

- To promote equality in distribution of land, ceiling has been imposed on the holding size.
- Ceiling on holding is the max size of cultivable land holding that an individual or a family can own.

Cooperative Farming

- Encouraged to enhance bargaining power of small holders.
- Together they can buy inputs at a lower price and sell their produce at a higher price.
