

MERCANTILISM

 During the 17th & 18th century group of men (merchants, bankers, government officials etc.) advocated an economic philosophy known as mercantilism.





Mercantilist Views

1-A nation can only become rich & powerful if they exported more than import.

2-The more bullion or gold & silver a nation had the richer and more powerful it was.

The Logic

More gold, rulers could maintain larger and better armies



- Make more colonies
- More money & greater business activity
- Greater the flow of goods & services to satisfy human wants
- Higher the standard of living in the nation.

3-Government should stimulate export and discourage import.

The logic: Government would stimulate national output and employment.

4-Advocated strict Government control of all economic activity & preached economic nationalism because they believed that a nation could gain in trade only at expense of other nations.
